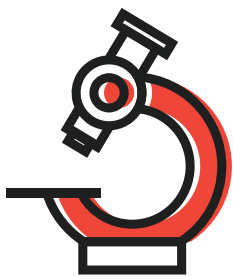

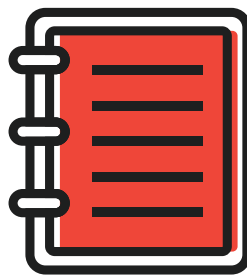
is a global campaign for ME health equality

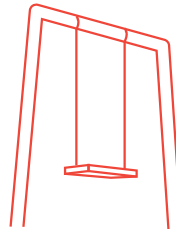
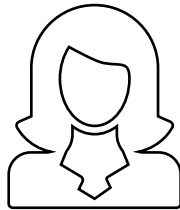

### WHO IS AT RISK?



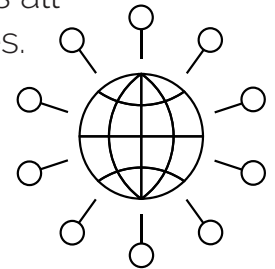
Affects between

women than men.



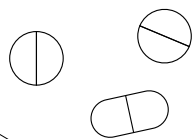
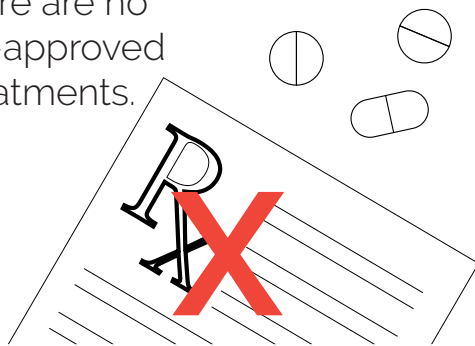
Seen in children

races.

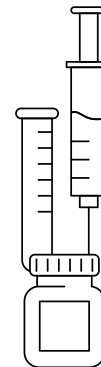


### WHAT IS THE TREATMENT?

treatments.



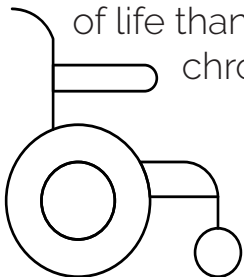
Some medications

drugs.

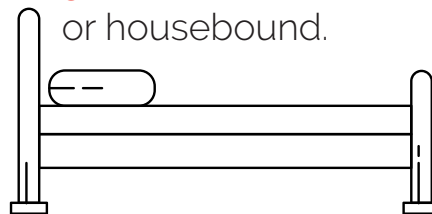
### HOW SERIOUS IS THE DISEASE?

Sufferers have a lower quality  
of life than patients with many

**75-85%**  
of patients are  
not able to work.

**and 25%** are bedbound  
or housebound.



Recovery is rare,  
**estimated at  
just 5%**, leaving  
patients sick for  
years, even  
decades.

### WHAT DOES IT COST OUR COUNTRY?

ME has a large personal and societal cost,

**\$17-24 BILLION** in estimated medical expenses  
and lost productivity due to  
patients' inability to work.
