

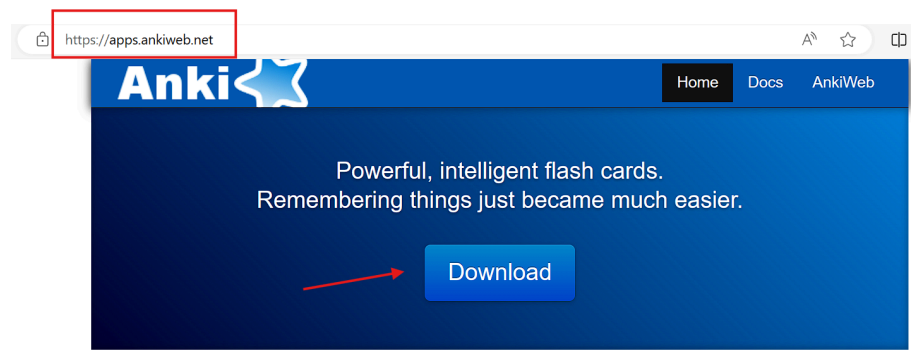
How to access the infection-associated chronic illnesses flashcard deck

If you already use AnkiHub for your medical studies:

1. Visit <https://app.ankihub.net/decks/0991ce84-9d41-410e-835d-183e2bea4c0b>
2. Sign in using your AnkiHub username and password.
3. Click “Subscribe”
4. In the Anki desktop application, sync with AnkiHub in the Ankihub addon menu.
5. Start studying!

If you're new to Anki:

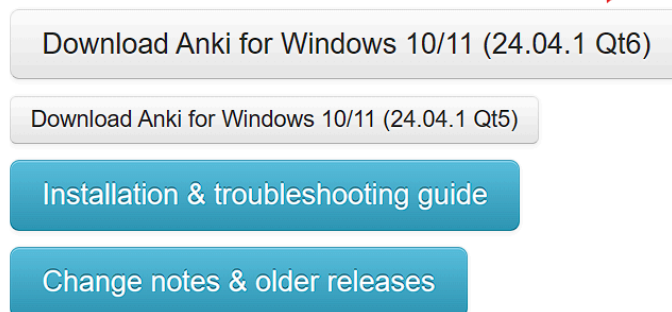
1. Download the Anki application
 - a. Download the application at <https://apps.ankiweb.net/> (macOS or Windows)



- b. Click the Qt6 download option.

Welcome to our Anki flashcard deck dedicated to **infection-associated chronic diseases!** In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, understanding conditions that may be **triggered or unmasked by infection** has become increasingly crucial. This includes diseases and disorders like **myalgic encephalomyelitis/chronic fatigue syndrome (ME/CFS)**, **Long COVID (PASC)**, **postural orthostatic tachycardia syndrome (POTS)**, ***mast cell activation disorders (MCAS)**, hypermobility disorder, **Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome**, and more. However, these patient populations are often underserved and diagnosis and best treatment practices may not be adequately covered in medical school curricula.

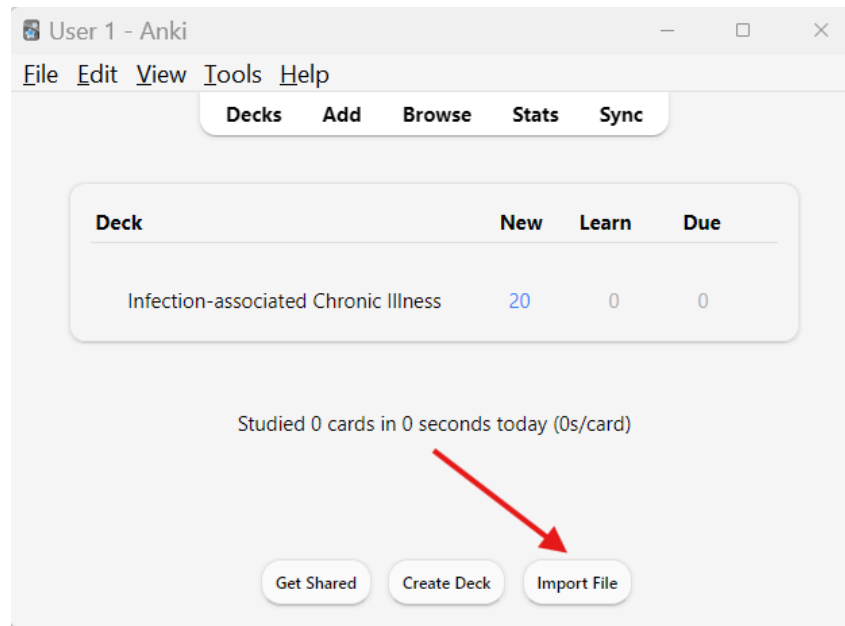

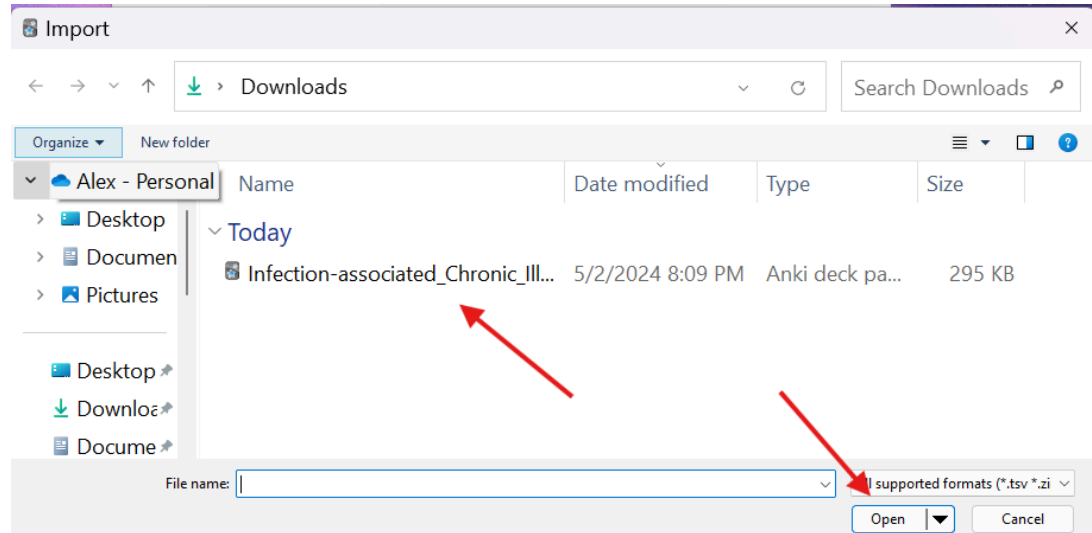
3. Import the deck into Anki

- Open the Anki application

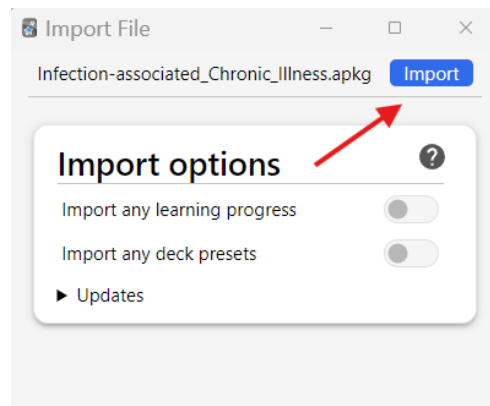
c. In the window that opens, select Import File



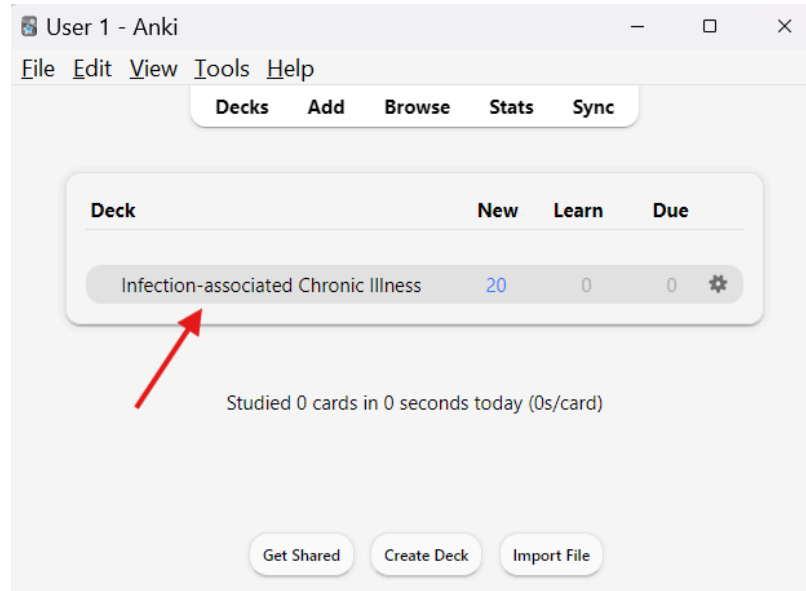
d. When prompted, select the deck that you previously downloaded - Click Open



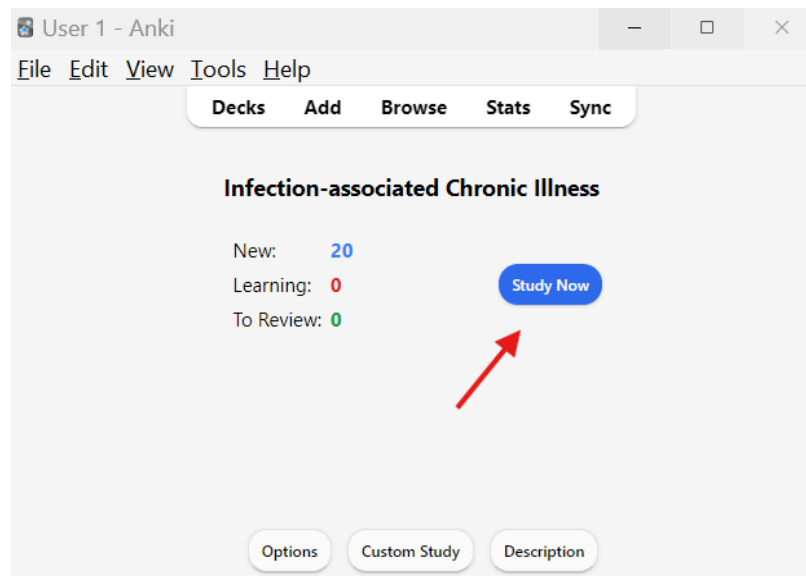
e. Click Import
